## The Idaho Career Information System

As Amended BY COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR; AMENDING SECTION 72-1333, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION FROM THE MERIT SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE IDAHO CAREER INFORMATION SYSTEM; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 13, TITLE 72, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 72-1345A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE IDAHO CAREER INFORMATION SYSTEM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE IDAHO CAREER INFORMATION SYSTEM ACCOUNT.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: SECTION 1.

72-1345A. IDAHO CAREER INFORMATION SYSTEM. The Idaho career information system is hereby established within the department to provide current and accurate occupational, educational and related career information to help Idaho citizens understand the link between educational preparation and work, explore education and career alternatives, and successfully seek work. The Idaho career information system shall be responsible for carrying out the duties required by 20 U.S.C. section 2328(c) of the Carl D. Perkins career and technical education act of 2006, as amended. All moneys received by the Idaho career information system for its products and services shall be deposited in the department's career information system account and are perpetually appropriated to the director for the administration of the Idaho career information system. Employees of the Idaho career information system shall be nonclassified employees exempt from the provisions of chapter 53, title 67, Idaho Code. The workforce development council established pursuant to section 72-1336, Idaho Code, shall serve as an advisory body to the department on matters related to the Idaho career information system.
