


# How to Verify Status With Driver's License Information

## How to Find an Idaho Driver's License Number to Verify Status for the Unemployment Claimant Portal.

1. Go to <http://www.itd.idaho.gov/dmv/>
2. Click ONLINE SERVICES

**Reinstating your Driving Privileges:**

When your suspension or revocation time ends, you may reinstate your driving privileges by applying to the Idaho Transportation Department. You may need to pay a reinstatement fee, which depending on the reason for the suspension, will range from \$15.00 to \$285.00 (or more if there are multiple suspensions).

Once any required suspension time has elapsed, and the reinstatement fee has been paid, additional actions may need to be taken to reinstate your driving privileges, i.e.:

- Provide proof and maintain proof of liability insurance coverage. The required method of providing this proof is an SR22 form sent to the department from your insurance carrier.
- Proof from the courts of payment of fines

**Disclaimers:**

- This site does not collect court fines.
- It may take up to two business days to process fee payments.
- You may need to take additional actions before your license can be reinstated.
- This transaction with Idaho may not clear you in other jurisdictions.
- Reinstatement fees are non-refundable.

**PRIOR TO OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE, YOU MUST HAVE A CURRENT AND VALID LICENSE IN YOUR POSSESSION.**  
You may obtain verification of your Idaho license status by returning to this site to check the status of your driving privileges. When all requirements are met, you will also receive a reinstatement letter from the department.

**NOTE:** Your address must be kept current with the department to receive correspondence from the department. Any address information provided during this online process DOES NOT change your drivers license address.
