Caldwell Workshop Set on Unemployment Insurance, Labor Laws

Idaho Department of Labor experts will discuss unemployment insurance and labor laws during a free three-hour workshop for supervisors, managers and human resource professionals on June 3 in Caldwell.

The workshop runs from 9 a.m. to noon at the department's Canyon County office, 4514 Thomas Jefferson St. in Caldwell.

Participants will get information on how to control unemployment insurance taxes with E-Services, when to document personnel issues and warnings, how to respond to a claim for unemployment insurance benefits, key points to consider in employee issues, timely replies and appeal rights, changes in unemployment insurance and tax laws and useful tools and services available at the local Labor office.

The department's wage and hour staff will also be available to answer questions.
