Correction Department to Hold Job Fairs in North Central Idaho

The Idaho Department of Correction is holding three job fairs this month to fill openings for correctional officers. The times and locations are:

Lewiston: Thursday, June 11, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Idaho Department of Labor, 1158 Idaho St.

Kamiah: Tuesday, June 16, 1 - 3 p.m., Chamber of Commerce Visiting Center, 518 Main St.

Orofino: Thursday, June 18, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Idaho Department of Labor, 410 Johnson Ave.

Correction personnel will conduct interviews during the fairs. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age and should bring a completed background investigation questionnaire, which can be found online at www.idoc.idaho.gov/content/careers/background_investigation_questionnaire.

Correctional officers receive a starting rate of \$13.66 an hour with competitive benefits and a pay increase after successful completion of entrance probation.
