Idaho's Workforce Development Task Force to Meet April 10

Education and career development topics are on the agenda for the Governor's Workforce Development Task Force meeting April 10. It runs from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in the East Side Conference Room on the first floor of the J.R. Williams Building, 700 W. State St. in Boise.

A college and career advising panel, scheduled for 10:30 to noon, features representatives from the Idaho State Board of Education, the Idaho State Department of Education, the Idaho School Counselors Association, College of Southern Idaho and Idaho PTECH Network.

Also on the agenda are presentations from the Idaho Career Information System and Idaho Career & Technical Education College and Career Readiness program. Representatives from Idaho Digital Learning Academy will lead a working lunch followed by an analysis and discussion of Idaho's workforce gap.
