

# Incarcerated Veterans Transition Program

**Are you a veteran who has been in jail/incarcerated?**

**Have you been released within the last 12 months?**

**Are you homeless, at risk of becoming homeless or placed into temporary housing upon release?**

**You may be eligible for services under the Incarcerated Veterans Transition Program.**

**Potential services include:**

- Classroom training
- On-the-job-training
- Occupational skills training
- Apprenticeship training
- Upgrade and retraining
- Funding for work tools and clothing.
- Transportation
- Child care
- Vehicle repairs
- Rent payment assistance

**The purpose of the grant is to ease the transition from incarceration to employment with support structure in place.**
