**Subject:** Measurable Skills Gain and Credential Services in IdahoWorks

# I. Purpose:

This WIOAP consolidates multiple changes and updates that have taken place since the issuance of WIOAP 12-19 *New Services in IdahoWorks* on April 1, 2020. This includes removing the service *Non-Occupational Skills Training* from the services chart(s). This WIOAP rescinds and replaces WIOAPS 06-22; 12-19; 12-19 Change 1; WIOAP 12-19, Change 2; and their accompanying attachments/references.

# II. Background:

When adding a new service for a participant in *IdahoWorks*, career planners/coaches are asked to answer, "Does this service lead to a credential, employment or a measurable skills gain?". The question must be answered Yes or No. It must not be left as N/A.

Below is revised guidance designed to help program staff answer the question and select their anticipated results.

## III. Policy:

- 1. Guidance for adding a new service to a participant's file:
  - A) Does this service lead to a credential, employment or a measurable skills gain?
    - For Adult and Dislocated Worker participants enrolling in any of the following services, answer YES to question A) above:
      - ABE or ESL in Combination with Training
      - Occupational Skills Training
      - OJT-On the Job Training
      - OJT- Registered Apprenticeship
      - Prerequisite Training
      - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training
      - Skill Upgrading
      - Entrepreneurial Training

- **For Youth participants** enrolling in the following services, answer *YES* to question A) above:
  - ABE or ESL in Combination with Training
  - Basic Skills Youth
  - Occupational Skills Training
  - Prerequisite Training
  - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training

**REMINDER** – Anytime question A) is answered with *YES (Adult, Dislocated Worker or Youth)*, a *Measurable Skills Gain* **MUST** also be selected as an outcome/result.

B) Select a result that the service may lead to:

If WIOA staff answered YES to question A) above, they must select an option from the lists below.

- Only Adult and Dislocated Worker participants enrolled in the following services may be shown as leading to a Credential. Choose one or more that apply:
  - ABE or ESL in Combination with Training
  - Occupational Skills Training
  - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training
  - Prerequisite Training
  - Skill Upgrading
- Only Adult and Dislocated Worker participants enrolled in the following services may be shown as leading to Employment. Choose one or more that apply:
  - OJT-On the Job Training
  - OJT-Registered Apprenticeship
  - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training
- Only Youth participants enrolled in the following services may be shown as leading to a Credential. Choose one or more that apply:
  - ABE or ESL in Combination with Training
  - Basic Skills
  - Occupational Skills Training
  - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training
  - Prerequisite Training
- Only Youth participants enrolled in the following services may be shown as leading to Employment. Choose it when it applies:
  - Registered Apprenticeship-Classroom Training

## 2. Guidance for service chart change related to Non-Occupational Skills Training:

As noted in the introduction of this WIOAP, the *Non-Occupational Skills* <u>Training</u> service has been removed from the services chart below. This service <u>does not</u> meet the federal definition of Occupational Skills Training and, therefore, does not support Measurable Skills Gain attainment. For clarification, the word *Training* has been replaced with *Instruction* in the service's title. The service is now titled *Non-Occupational Skills Instruction* in the *IdahoWorks* Service and Training Plan.
