



# Industry-Driven Skills Training Fund (IDSTF)

## Power your workforce. Accelerate your growth.

IDSTF supports Idaho employers investing in advanced manufacturing technologies across innovation-driven industries — including nuclear energy, mineral extraction and precision manufacturing.

### What does this funding provide?

Employers can get up to 80% reimbursement for approved training costs (up to \$25,000 per employee) to expand their workforce or upskill current employees.

#### Training can include:

- Approved training with local Idaho schools
- Customized/vendor-led programs
- Specialized skills
- On-the-Job Training (OJT)

#### Not covered as training (nonreimbursable):

- Employee onboarding
- Recurring compliance or safety refreshers
- Enterprise resource planning (ERP) system training
- Sales training
- Executive leadership training
- Temporary or contract positions

### Who can apply for this funding?

Any Idaho-based business.

### When to apply for this funding?

Applications are being **accepted now**, on a rolling, first-come, first-serve basis until funds are depleted. Contracts range up to 2–3 years.

### Why apply for this funding?

- Expand capacity.
- Fill critical skill gaps.
- Retain trained employees.
- Strengthen competitive advantage.
