

Logging into the Claimant Portal with ID.me

Why do I need to log in using ID.me?

All unemployment insurance (UI) claimants must sign in to ID.me before accessing Claimant Portal. Using ID.me to verify your identity helps us confirm you are the person filing for unemployment insurance and not someone pretending to be you.

You will need to sign into ID.me any time you access the Claimant Portal. Each time you log in, you will type in your email address and password. Then, you will be prompted to complete the process by entering a 6-digit code from your cell phone to ID.me.

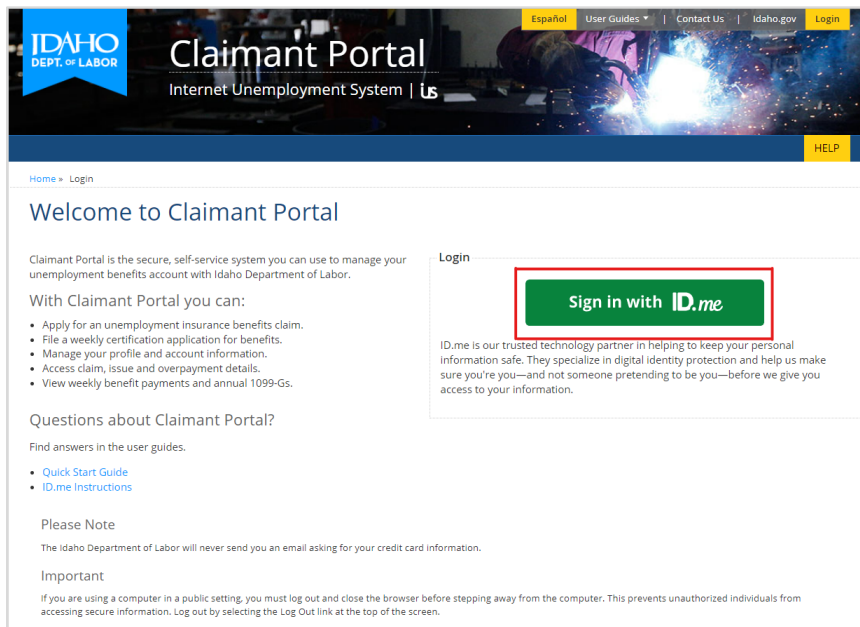
Note: If you do not have a cell phone, visit an Idaho Department of Labor office to sign in and complete the process. Visit the department's office directory to find a location near you.

We recommend you schedule an appointment before visiting a local office. UI navigators are available at some locations to guide you through the UI system. Contact your nearest office at the phone number listed in the directory. You can also speak to a claim specialist at 208-332-8942 for help with scheduling an appointment.

Once you complete the identity verification process, you will be able to access the Claimant Portal as normal.

Use the following steps to log in:

1. Go to the [Claimant Portal](#).



2. Click on the **Sign in with ID.me** button.

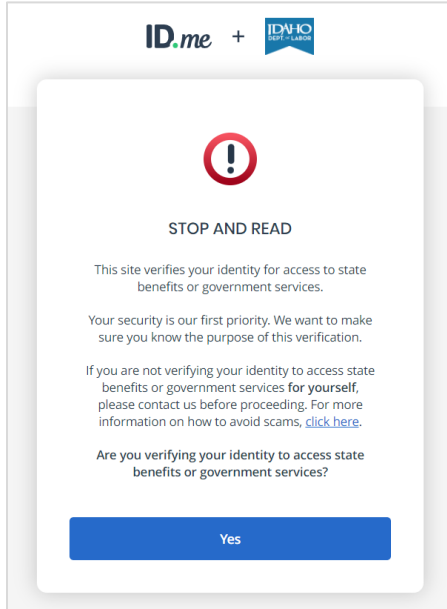
- The following screen will appear. Type in your email address and password, then click the **Sign in** button.

If you do **NOT** have an ID.me account, click on **Create an ID.me account**. For information on the identity verification process, see how to [verify with ID.me for the Idaho Department of Labor](#).

- Choose how you want to receive your sign-in code. Make your selection, then click **Continue**.

- After clicking Continue, you will see the following screen. You will receive your code either through text or phone call based on the option you chose. Enter the code and click **Continue**.

- You will see the following screen. Read the statement and click **Yes**. You will then be returned to the Claimant Portal.



- You are now logged into the Claimant Portal and can access all your account information as normal.
