## If you are authorized to live and work in the United States but are not a U.S. citizen:

You must enter your Alien and Card numbers when you apply for unemployment benefits. The images below will help you find these numbers.

## I-766 EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION CARD



The **Alien Number** is the 9-digit number under *USCIS#* on the front of your card. This number is also on the back of your card.

The **Card Number** is on the back of your card and starts with 3 letters followed by 10 numbers. This number is also on the front of you I-766 Employment Authorization card.

If you do not have a card number, enter: AAA000000000 (3 As and 10 zeros)
